

1. Norwich City Football Club's (the "Club") official partner, Visit Tampa Bay, is providing supporters the opportunity to participate in a half-time challenge (the "Challenge") for the chance to win a trip to Tampa Bay, subject to the conditions below.
2. Entrants must be aged 18 or over. As part of the entry form, the supporter must confirm that they are over the age of 18.
3. The Challenge will require the participants* (two (2) individuals) to correctly answer questions on the pitch at the Club's stadium. The winner will be the contestant with the most correct answers. In the eventuality of a tie, a tie break question will be used to determine the winner.
4. The winner of each challenge shall be entered into a draw of contestants who each won matchday challenge where a winner of the trip to Tampa shall be picked at random.

8. Each winner of a Challenge, and the winner of the Final Challenge, may be required to take part in publicity activity and all Entrants agree to take part in such publicity activity as the Club may require upon reasonable notice without further compensation.
9. By submitting the entry form, the Entrant is deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions. The Club reserves the right to withdraw the operation of the Challenges at any time.
10. The Challenge is not open to employees of the Club. Any such individuals who enter the Challenge, shall be automatically disqualified.

11. The entry into the draw to participate in the Challenge shall be restricted to one entry per person.

12. Once an Entrant has participated in the Challenge, they shall no longer be eligible to be drawn to participate again.

13. Before participating in the Challenge, an Entrant will be required to confirm that there are no medical grounds which would make it unsuitable for them to participate in the Challenge, and that they are aware of the nature of the Challenge and will be participating at their own risk.

14. These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and any disputes shall be subject to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
